

Regular screenings are another crucial line of defense, enabling breast cancer to be detected at its earliest and most treatable stage.

Current guidelines recommend that women of average risk start receiving screening mammograms at age 40. Depending on their personal or family health history, their doctors may recommend starting earlier.

For women with dense breast tissue-nearly half of women over 40-breast ultrasounds may also be recommended. These scans provide a different view of the breast that helps distinguish between benign fluid-filled cysts and solid masses.

#### Compassionate, Quality Care

The Women's Center at Broward Health Coral Springs provides expert, personalized care in a welcoming environment designed to make patients feel at ease.

"Quality care and patient comfort are at the heart of everything we do," said Roberto Martinez, regional radiology manager at Broward Health Coral Springs.

Reflected in the center's use of 3D mammogram machines with curved paddles designed to enhance

comfort, patients are assured knowing the center's five expert mammographers have a combined experience of more than 100 years, and that their scans are read by a dedicated breast radiologist.

Broward Health Coral Springs' recent accreditation in breast ultrasound from the American College of Radiology further demonstrates its dedication to maintaining the highest standards of care.

#### **Advanced Surgical Options**

If patients are diagnosed with breast cancer, Broward Health Coral Springs offers an advanced surgical option for breast-conserving surgeries like lumpectomy. The SAVI SCOUT® surgical guidance system provides a more convenient option for marking tissue that needs to be removed, as compared to traditional needle localization. Radiologists place a small reflector about the size of a grain of rice to mark the tumor, days in advance of the surgery. During surgery, the reflector is activated for use with the guidance system.

"This system enables us to perform a more precise surgery with the potential to remove less tissue," said Jose Martin, D.O., chair of surgery at Broward Health Coral Springs. "It also offers a more comfortable and convenient experience for our patients, which is always our goal."

## **From Braces to Breast Cancer**

A typical pair of Coral Springs Middle School students, Kathy Berk and Denyse Fier met when they were both 14. They attended Taravella High School together, graduating and moving on to different colleges, but all the while remaining close and connected. Though it's been more than 40 years since their first meeting, Denyse says, "Kathy and I have shared so much of our lives together. We have been very close through all of the years – no matter what curve balls have come our way."

Kathy is equally complimentary of her childhood friend. She says, "Denying and I immediately formed a friendship like no other. I moved away for several years once I got married and our friendship only blossomed more. Denyse is like my sister. She is ALWAYS there for me and my family no matter what the issue at hand is. I can call her anytime of the day or night and she will come running."

Kathy underscores her point when she talks about her battle with infertility and how Denyse, an RN, MSN, helped her get through trying to conceive her children for so many years. Kathy continues, "She would give me injection after injection, night after night, week after week and month after month. She accompanied me on my doctor visits and unselfishly gave up her time every day, sometimes at 3:00 or 4:00 in the morning to give me the injection I needed to go through Invitro fertilization with my husband."

And then, things changed ....Kathy says, "The day I got a call from Denyse telling me that she had breast cancer, my first thought was that this could not be happening to my friend that I have had for a lifetime. My next thought was, she is a fighter and she is the strongest

person I know. The months after her diagnosis were extremely painful for Denyse, but for me as well. I sat by her bedside bringing her strawberry milkshakes (the only thing that seemed to have the least bit of taste) and was with her during her chemo treatments. She was surrounded by so many friends who love her!"

Denyse's huge battle included a double mastectomy. With so many friends encouraging her, she began the fundraising effort we know today as Not My Daughter...find a cure now! Denyse tells us, "Kathy is a very special person, a true friend, someone I can ALWAYS count on! She is always giving, never expecting anything in return. We have gone from braces to breast cancer together." From the trials and tribulations of high school, through different colleges, to weddings, children and every step in between. Denyse (now Hostig) and Kathy (now Sherbal) have the shared history to joke that they have "turned into their mothers" and the strength of a lifelong bond that takes them through to the next generation.

Through organizational and fundraising efforts, these two strong women (together with dozens of others who have joined their mission) are working to ensure that their children have a future filled with promise and hope for an end to breast cancer. Kathy feels blessed to have had a friend like Denyse for most of her life. "Denyse's nature is always helping others.," she says. "That is why she turned the fight of her life into creating Not My Daughter....find a cure now! For the Raskins, kindness is a guiding principle. As Dara shares, "Always be kind—you never know what people are going through." It's a message the family embodies through their community involvement, support for one another, and the way they approach life in Parkland.





## Aging Knees? By Dr. Brandon C. Maisel

Knee osteoarthritis is a common pathology affecting millions of Americans. The cause of osteoarthritis is multifactorial. It may be genetics, mechanical wear and tear, increased inflammation, increased body mass or all the above. Dr. Maisel describes it as "you are born with brand new tread on your tires (knee cartilage) and as you put more miles on that tread, it wears down." Muscle weakness, more specifically quadriceps weakness may result from osteoarthritis. Formal physical therapy offered here at Gelb Sports Medicine and Orthopedic Center is the first step to pain reduction. Subsequently, the patient will develop a home exercise program to maintain their strength. In conjunction with therapy, prescribed anti-inflammatory medication and injections will be offered. We provide corticosteroid (cortisone), viscosupplementation and platelet rich plasma injections. All injections may be performed under ultra-sound guidance to ensure accurate placement. Cortisone injections will offer more immediate relief within 3-5 days post injection. If the above measures fail, we will progress to viscosupplementation otherwise known as "gel" injections. Viscosupplementation injections main component is hyaluronic acid. Hyaluronic acid will increase the lubrication and shock absorption within the knee joint. Lastly, regenerative medication is becoming a leading form of treatment for musculoskeletal ailments. Platelet rich plasma is derived from your own blood, concentrated in a syringe and injected into the knee joint. Platelet rich plasma or PRP can offer cartilage protection and reduction in inflammatory markers. Dr. Maisel will work with you at every stage to ultimately obtain pain relief from osteoarthritis! class treatment for a variety of South Florida patients - including University of Miami Hurricanes athletes.





# Essential Tips for Trick-or-Treaters

Happy Halloween! I'm Dr. Ilana Gersowsky, the newest physician at Sawgrass Pediatrics. I'm excited to be a part of this wonderful team and look forward to providing compassionate, attentive care to our patients. I can't wait to meet you and your children!

To ensure a safe and enjoyable Halloween, here are a few important tips to keep in mind:

1. Costume Safety: Make your child's costume more visible by incorporating bright colors or glow sticks, so

they can be easily seen. Ensure that costumes do not obstruct their eyes, nose, or mouth and that they fit properly to prevent tripping or discomfort.

- 2. Pedestrian Safety: Safety while walking is essential. Stick to sidewalks, cross at designated crosswalks, and stay in well-lit areas. Teach children about traffic safety and the importance of following pedestrian rules. Always supervise young children while trick-or-treating.
- **3. Stay Cool:** Halloween in Florida can be hot! Dress children in cooler costumes, bring water, and never leave a child unattended in a vehicle.






